COVID-19

As part of the national social distancing measures to limit the spread of COVID-19, schools are currently open to vulnerable children and children of key workers only. From the week commencing 1st June 2020, at the earliest, the Department for Education is asking primary schools to extend their provision to children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 6.

In preparing for this phased return, the Leadership Team and Governors have closely followed Government guidelines and their scientific advice with regard to protective measures; in addition to local advice from the Essex Local Authority. A comprehensive risk assessment has been conducted to inform our phased return. Our initial offer is for Reception Class and Year One. Please refer to the separate letter sent out to all parents earlier today for further information.


Creative Class 2


