

A selection of activities which may be covered this term in Year 4.

### Mathematics

- Number – Continue to consolidate knowledge of multiplication facts to 12x12. Continue to consolidate the formal methods covered so far.
- Fractions – Recognise some common equivalent fractions, add and subtract fractions with the same denominator
- Decimals – Understand the place value for tenths and hundredths, recognise the effect of multiplying or dividing decimals by 10 and 100.
- Money – converting pounds to pence and solving money problems.

### Science

- Continue to develop investigative skills.
- Understand how the digestive system works.
- Identify the different types of teeth and their functions.
- Construct a variety of food chains.
- Understand how sounds are made and how we hear them.

### English

- Continue the work on the Writing Checklist
- Fiction genres – Fables and character descriptions
- Non-fiction genres – explanations and non-chronological reports
- Poetry – poems in a range of forms
- Reading comprehension
- Spelling patterns/rules

### Computing

- Continue to learn about online safety, how to keep safe and what to share and not to share.
- Learn early programming skills.
- variables and use repetitions/loops.
- Use of the Internet for research
- Continue to develop skills in combining software to present and publish work.

### History

- Research Greek life and achievements and study their influence on the western world.
- Use different information sources.
- Discuss the reliability of different information sources.

### Geography

- Compare the weather of different regions.

### PE

- Develop fielding skills, co-ordination and strength when playing cricket.
- Develop team building, balance, problem solving, planning and decision making when taking part in Outdoor and Adventurous.

### RE

- Pentecost – God's transforming power Learning about the symbols and what they mean.

### French

- Name different modes of transport.
- Ask and answer questions.
- Use familiar vocabulary in simple sentences.

### DT

- Research different types of breads and flours
- Research Greek recipes and flavours
- Design and make a bread with flavours inspired from Greece
- Evaluate the finished product against the agreed criteria.

### PSHEE

- Learn about anti-social behaviour and how media present information
- Resolving conflicts
- Learn about their role within their community and the wider world
- SRE – discuss changes as they grow, understand what a period is (girls only) and know about life cycles.
