Find a fostering option to suit you

Even the smallest amount of time can make the biggest difference to a child's life. Foster from one weekend a month to providing full-time support.

Mainstream fostering

- ✓ Full-time and part-time options available.
- ✓ Receive up to £483 per week, per child.
- ✓ Children aged 0–18.
- ✓ Suitable for someone who is patient, kind and has time to help a child overcome their trauma.

Fostering children with disabilities

- ✓ Full-time and part-time options available from one weekend a month.
- √ £500-£1000 per week for full-time care, plus allowances.

- ✓ Children aged 0–18. The majority of our children do not need to be cared for in a specially adapted home.
- ✓ Ideally someone with personal or professional experience for caring or children with disabilities or transferable skills.
- ✓ Respite for carers.

Supported Lodgings

- ✓ Receive £250 per week, per child. Each young person receives a personal allowance of £61.05 per week.
- ✓ Children aged 16+ who need assistance with:
 - getting into education, training or work
 - managing money
 - learning to cook and do housework
 - attending appointments
 - building confidence
- ✓ Ideally someone who has the time and patience to support a young person with independent living skills and offer emotional support.
