Should we ever have a notable snowfall, please ensure that your child has wellingtons or boots for playtime and lunch time - they will not be allowed to play in snow in their usual school shoes. Children will also be expected to wear long trousers and not shorts if we have snow. Please can we request that all uniform and outerwear is named. Outside games lessons continue this term and it is really helpful for children to have skins, school tracksuits or school jumpers to keep them warm. The long PE socks are also helpful for warmth, as well as holding shin pads, for Key Stage 2 pupils and these can be obtained on-line from our school uniform supplier or plain navy blue ones can be found at many well known retailers.
