Dear Children and Parents,

Welcome to Class Three, I hope you have all enjoyed the summer break and are ready for an exciting term ahead. I appreciate that some children and parents may be feeling apprehensive about the return to school following the summer break and the transition to Key Stage Two. Please do not hesitate to contact me if you require any support for you or your child this term, or to update me of any changes/issues that may affect your child in school.

Class Topic

Our topic this term is 'Class Three Rocks!' This topic focuses on life in Britain from the Stone Age to the Iron Age and will incorporate the scientific study of rocks and soils. Links will be made to this topic in other curriculum areas where appropriate; please see accompanying topic web for more details of what your child will be learning. A 'Stone Age Survival Day' has been arranged to Flag Fen, Peterborough on Friday 22nd November, more information will follow closer to the time.

Staffing

I will be teaching Class Three every day, except on Tuesday mornings when Mrs Munday will teach the class. Mrs Chambers and Mrs Mosely will provide the additional classroom support throughout the week.

P.E.

P.E. will usually take place on a Monday. Children should come to school in their P.E. kit and trainers on Mondays. Information about uniform expectations, including P.E. kit can be found on the school website. Swimming lessons will take place on Wednesday mornings (starting on 11th September). Detailed information about swimming was sent to parents via email at the end of the summer term; please refer to the letter received for full information and ensure you have given permission via Arbor.

Art and DT

Please could children bring into school a named overall/old shirt to protect their clothes during art lessons and creative activities. Art shirts can be left in school in the children's lockers.

Homework

In Year Three children are expected to: read aloud to an adult every day, practise their times tables every day and complete one weekly maths and spelling task. Please help your child to establish a consistent homework routine and support them when completing their homework.

Even if your child is a fluent reader, they should still read aloud to an adult for 10 minutes each day and listen to texts being read aloud regularly as this benefits them in many ways. All reading should be recorded in your child's planner. Please could all parents sign and date the planner each week - these will be checked on a Friday but should be in school every day.

Children will be set a weekly written, or online, maths task each Friday. This will usually be related to what is being taught in maths lessons that week; maths tasks should take approximately 20 minutes. Additionally, children will be set a spelling activity on a weekly basis via their school planner. This may be learning a given list of spellings or completing work based on a spelling pattern/rule. Children are expected to practise times tables daily. Fluency in times tables and related division facts is essential for maths development. Regular practise on apps such as TT Rock Stars will support with this. Please see the planner for login details.

Spellings and times tables will be tested in school on a weekly basis.
